

Ordering Mobile Diagnostic Imaging for an LTC+ Resident

Monday – Sunday: 8AM – 5PM

Please Note: Due to current staffing pressures, expedited imaging services are no longer available on the weekend in the Toronto region.

At this time, expedited orthopedic imaging via STL Imaging is strictly reserved for those homes that have been onboarded onto the LTC+ Fracture Pathway

1	<p>Fill out STL Imaging Requisition Form</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Complete resident details: Add resident sticker/stamp or fill in the resident's name, HCN, version code, and DOB <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Check off the requested mobile x-ray/ultrasound examination(s). Complete appropriate clinical information: Indicate the reason for the examination and whether the resident is a COVID-19 + or a Person Under Investigation (PUI). <ul style="list-style-type: none"> If expedited orthopedic imaging is required, please note LTC+ designation at the top of the requisition form Include the PCP's contact and billing details: Name, OHIP billing number, and phone number for the resident's unit <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The PCP or RN must sign and date the form
2	<p>Fax the requisition form to: 1-855-374-3497</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> If expedited orthopedic imaging is required, phone 1-800-268-5804 to ensure the requisition has been received STL will send a technologist the same/next day, depending on volumes, staffing and distance to travel
3	<p>Meet the Technologist</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The technologist will wear PPE for every examination as a precaution (regardless of whether resident is under contact/droplet isolation).
4	<p>Receive the Imaging Results</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All orthopedic imaging exams marked as LTC+ will be read by the radiologist on the same day they are received Positive findings will be telephoned to the resident's unit indicated on the requisition form and faxed to the main facility. All other reports will be faxed back to the main facility
